Re: DEMANDS FOR INVESTIGATIONS, PROSECUTIONS AND OTHER SERVICES

Dear Sheriff Shrader and District Attorney Weir:

This letter is confidential. Do not share it, or any of my evidence, or any of my communications, with anyone listed below in footnotes 1 and 2, or with anyone outside your immediate offices, without my permission.

Enclosed are copies of the relevant portions of the first of several lawsuits to be filed in the coming weeks, and an exhibit in a recent family law matter containing enough evidence to establish probable cause of several of the crimes alleged in the complaint. I have thousands of pages of documentary evidence and other forms of evidence to fully prove my claims.

The purpose of this letter is to demand comprehensive investigations, by both your offices, into the "crime spree" against my family over the past eleven years, and to demand prosecution of the suspects to the fullest extent of the law, in behalf of myself and my five children: Bubba (age 23), Speedy (age 22), Buddy (age 20), Smarty (age 19), and Sweetie (age 17) Doe, who I haven't seen for over 8-½ years due to the crime spree. All of my children were minors when the crimes occurred. No statute of limitations has begun to toll – *see endnote i*.

In addition to my ex-wife Jane's thefts, frauds and child abuses, we are victims of "case fixing" and other crimes by judicial officials¹ in Jefferson County, and of obstruction of justice, misprision of felony and other crimes by your predecessors and other employees in your offices². And because no one has ever investigated the crimes, magistrate Jamin Alabiso and judge Christopher Zenisek are currently fixing my recent motions against me in case 2005DR212.

At this point, I do not know if I will be suing and pressing charges against Alabiso and Zenisek. I would like to focus on the thefts and conspiracies alleged in the enclosed complaint, and see how

it goes with my recent family law matter.

I ask that you open investigations in both your offices and either communicate with me yourselves or appoint experienced investigators to our case and ask them to contact me. I would like to play an active role in your investigations and in the prosecutions, and I am happy to do so to prevent harm to anyone else in Jefferson County. I will be requesting transcripts of interviews and written results of your investigations along the way for my civil actions.

As stated in the complaint, I have given Jane numerous opportunities to return my things and do the right thing, and I have given most of the other defendants at least one opportunity to settle the matters, but no one responded, and so I will now be pressing full charges against them. I am giving Jon and Karen B., Jenny R. and Hillarie G. an opportunity to settle my claims, and will contact you to press charges against them if they fail to do so.

Please start by making an unscheduled visit to 456 Any Street to document the eight vehicles and other things on my MASTER LIST in *Exhibit CO-101* that are still in Jane's possession. I have the original titles and bills of sale shown in the exhibit.

As soon as you have verified the essential elements of probable cause of one or more of their crimes, I ask that you arrest Hugger, Niermann and Jane to start, and that you contact me at least 24-hours prior to Jane's arrest so I can arrange for the well-being of my daughter.

DEMANDS FOR INVESTIGATIONS, PROSECUTIONS AND OTHER SERVICES:

On behalf of my children and myself, I hereby make demand for all services in the Colorado Criminal Justice System, including but not limited to the following:

1. Comprehensive detection and investigation;
2. Arrests (or summons) of the suspects;
3. Protection from further harm;
4. Whistleblower protection, if necessary;
5. Crime victim reparations and full crime victim services for all six of us;
6. Prosecution of the suspects to the fullest extent of the law;
7. Requests to the court for full and timely restitution;
8. Requests to the court for appropriate fines, imprisonment and other punishment; and
9. All other rights of crime victims pursuant to Colorado law.

Please realize in the beginning that my five children and I have done nothing wrong. We are innocent crime victims and we are still being abused. We need protection and relief. Toward that end, I ask that you both oversee the investigations and actions taken in my family's cases. Feel free to contact me anytime.

Re: Your allegations regarding your former wife and others

Dear Mr. Doe :

We have received your letter of December 21, 2015, in which you have requested "investigations, prosecutions and other services" with respect to your former wife and other persons associated with the Jefferson County domestic relations action numbered 00 DR 000.

Our review of your complaint – as well as complaints you have made to state and federal courts in Colorado and Minnesota – has led us to conclude that the matters about which you have written are properly within the purview of the domestic relations court and the appellate courts which review divorce court rulings. As such, we have determined that there is no reasonable likelihood of conviction of any of the persons you have named in your complaint as prospective defendants, even if we were to adopt your view that Colorado's criminal statute of limitations has not expired.

Therefore, we are ethically bound not to proceed with the investigation or prosecution you have demanded. While we regret that this situation has been so difficult for you personally, it is our belief that the legal resolution of this matter must be found in the civil courts, without the interference of law enforcement officials.

Dear Sheriff Shrader and District Attorney Weir:

This letter is confidential. Do not share it, or any of my evidence, or any of my communications, with anyone listed in footnotes 1 and 2 of my letter dated December 21, 2015, or with anyone outside your immediate offices, without my permission.

As you know, the crimes committed against my family are *your* responsibility; not the family court's responsibility, as Assistant District Attorney Michael Dougherty states in his letter.

As you also know, it does not matter that some of the crimes were committed in the context of my ex-wife's divorce. And, just so you know, the thefts and other crimes that you are now aware of (from the enclosures with my December 21, 2015 letter) are only a small fraction of the crimes that I can prove, and will be reporting to you in the coming months.

I'm sick and tired of the run around I've received from your offices and other Jeffco officials over the past 10 years. Please end the neglect *now*. My family has been through enough.

Another purpose of this letter is to request that both offices start with the theft of my 8 vehicles. I want to press immediate charges against Jane for aggravated motor vehicle theft in the first degree pursuant to C.R.S. 18-4-409(2)(a), a class 4 felony; and I want to press immediate charges against Hugger for his role in this theft – see ¶¶ 188, 247 in *complaint*. They have also committed ongoing fraud by concealment of the facts of the vehicles.

From this point on, I request direct responses from Mr. Weir and Mr. Shrader, unless your assistants are willing to do their jobs. Please respond to confirm that you are fulfilling my requests in the previous paragraph of this letter and my requests in my January 11th letter.

This letter is sent to you via the only email address I could find online for your office. In previous letters, I requested a secure email address for my communications with your office, but have still not received a response to this request. Please provide me with your email address for future communications. Otherwise, I will continue to use prussel@jeffco.us.

Attached is my FIRST CRIMINAL COMPLAINT (which I realize your office will rewrite on it's own forms). For Count 1 and Count 2, I cited the specific laws violated, but I am not sure what law to cite for the fraud alleged in Count 3; perhaps the suspects violated C.R.S. § 18-5-114. Offering a false instrument for recording.

As suggested by Assistant District Attorney Michael Dougherty, I sent this complaint to the chief judge, but found out today that that was incorrect, and so I asked his office to forward it to your office. If you want me to provide future complaints in a different form or format, please advise.

Please submit your complaint and request the appropriate warrants as soon as possible. Also, for the third time, I ask that you initiate full crime victim services for my five children and me pursuant to Article II, Section 16a of Colorado's Constitution, C.R.S. §§ 24-4.1-100.1 to 24-4.1-305, and all other laws under which we can find protection from further harm.

Dear Mr. Doe,

We received your letter of February 9, 2016 in which you request our office investigate and prosecute your ex-wife, Jane Doe, and John Charles Hugger. We reviewed all of the documentation that you provided. In addition to your most recent communication, we also have your complaint to this office in December, 2015, and a letter written to you in 2009 by then-District Attorney Scott Storey. I have also reviewed the response that I sent you to in January of this year.

In 2009, District Attorney Storey determined that your complaint is not a criminal justice issue. He advised you that, if you believe our refusal to prosecute is unjustified, pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-5-209, a judge of the court having jurisdiction of the alleged offense may require the filing of a criminal case and the appointment of a special prosecutor. If you wish to pursue this course, the statute requires that you file an affidavit with a judge alleging the commission of a crime and the unjustified refusal of our office to prosecute. You are welcome to do so, although I do not believe your allegations warrant a criminal prosecution.

Following a thorough review of your complaint, and your previous complaints, our position remains the same. There is no reasonable likelihood of conviction of any of the persons you have named in your complaint as prospective defendants. Therefore, we are ethically bound to not proceed with the investigation or prosecution you have demanded. It is our belief that any legal resolution to your situation should be sought in civil court. I appreciate your bringing these issues to our attention.
